The Glendale Police Department is now offering a Day Worker Program as an alternative to serving time in the County Jail.

WHAT IS THE DAY WORKER PROGRAM? The Day Worker Program offers an alternative to serving time in the county jail. Individuals approved for the Day Worker Program will check in daily, complete work details within the jail for a period of twelve hours per day, then check out - to sleep in the comfort of their own home every night.

HOW WILL MY TIME BE CALCULATED? Your time will be calculated just as if you were serving time in a lock down facility. For every six days worked, you will be given credit for one day good time and one day work time. If you are sentenced to serve thirty days in county jail, you would get five days good time and five days work time for a total commitment of twenty days. With the courts permission, you will be allowed to serve those same twenty consecutive days in our facility, but go home every night.

WHAT WILL MY WORK SCHEDULE BE? Once you have a start date, you will be required to report every day and work a schedule of 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.

WHAT DOES IT COST? As a pilot program, our Day Worker Program is offered at no cost.

HOW WILL I KNOW IF I QUALIFY? You must not have any physical limitations that would restrict your ability to work, and not be taking prescribed medication that would need to be administered while you are here. You must have a valid residence, be

clean and well groomed and have a current negative TB skin test. Due to housing constraints, only male subjects will be accepted in the program at this time.

HOW DO I APPLY? Contact the Glendale City Jail at (818) 548-3124 and ask to schedule an interview with the on duty supervisor.

WHAT WILL I NEED TO BRING? Once you have been scheduled to meet with a jail supervisor, you will need to bring the following:

- 1) Picture ID
- 2) Court commitment order indicating the courts approval to serve a work furlough program at the Glendale City Jail.
- 3) A current negative TB skin test result. (less than 30 days)
- 4) A picture ID will be required during every visit to the city jail.

WHERE ARE YOU LOCATED? The Glendale Police Department is located at 140 N. Isabel St. From the 134 freeway, exit at Glendale and go south to Wilson. Turn right on Wilson and we are located on the corner of Wilson and Isabel St.
